


- Open up an Internet browser (Google Chrome, Microsoft Edge, etc.)

 - Unit leader can give you your BSA Member ID if needed






- There may be a quiz to review what you have learned
 - o Select the answer(s) and click Submit




- When the course is completed, it should return you to the Learning Plan
